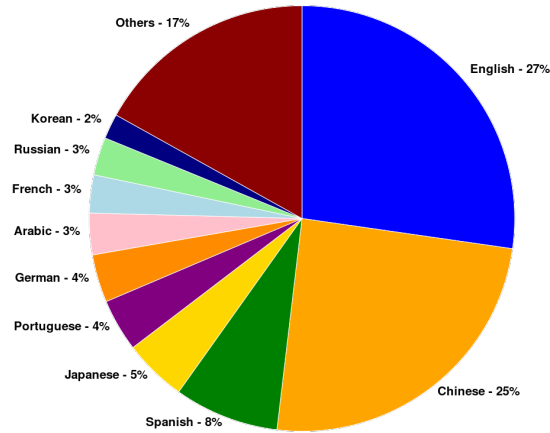


Figure 1: Internet users by language graph [1]
